A scenic park nestled in Ozarks-like wooded hills near the Missouri River bluffs. With 1500 expansive acres and 400 acre stocked lake, Lake Park offers all the amenities of a regional park.

Wildlife include Whitetail Deer, Opossum, Raccoon, Cottontail Rabbit, Red Fox, Beaver, Fox and Gray Squirrels.

Each of the 16 Shelter Houses has water, electricity, restroom, and playground equipment. Reservations required.

Boating & Fishing in Season (permits req.)
Lake elevation 830 ft.
Greatest depth 60 ft.
No swimming.

Dam was a WPA Project during 1930's

Hills are formed from loess, a silty glacial deposit of varying thickness, over limestone bedrock.

Park has over 50 picnic areas with about 300 picnic tables.

Native woodlands are hillside oak and hickory with lakeside sycamores.

Bird-watching is popular. Look for waterfowl, Wild Turkey, migrating species, & possible Bald Eagle sightings in winter.

Rustic stone hall with air conditioning, fireplaces, kitchen, & stage. Capacity 150.

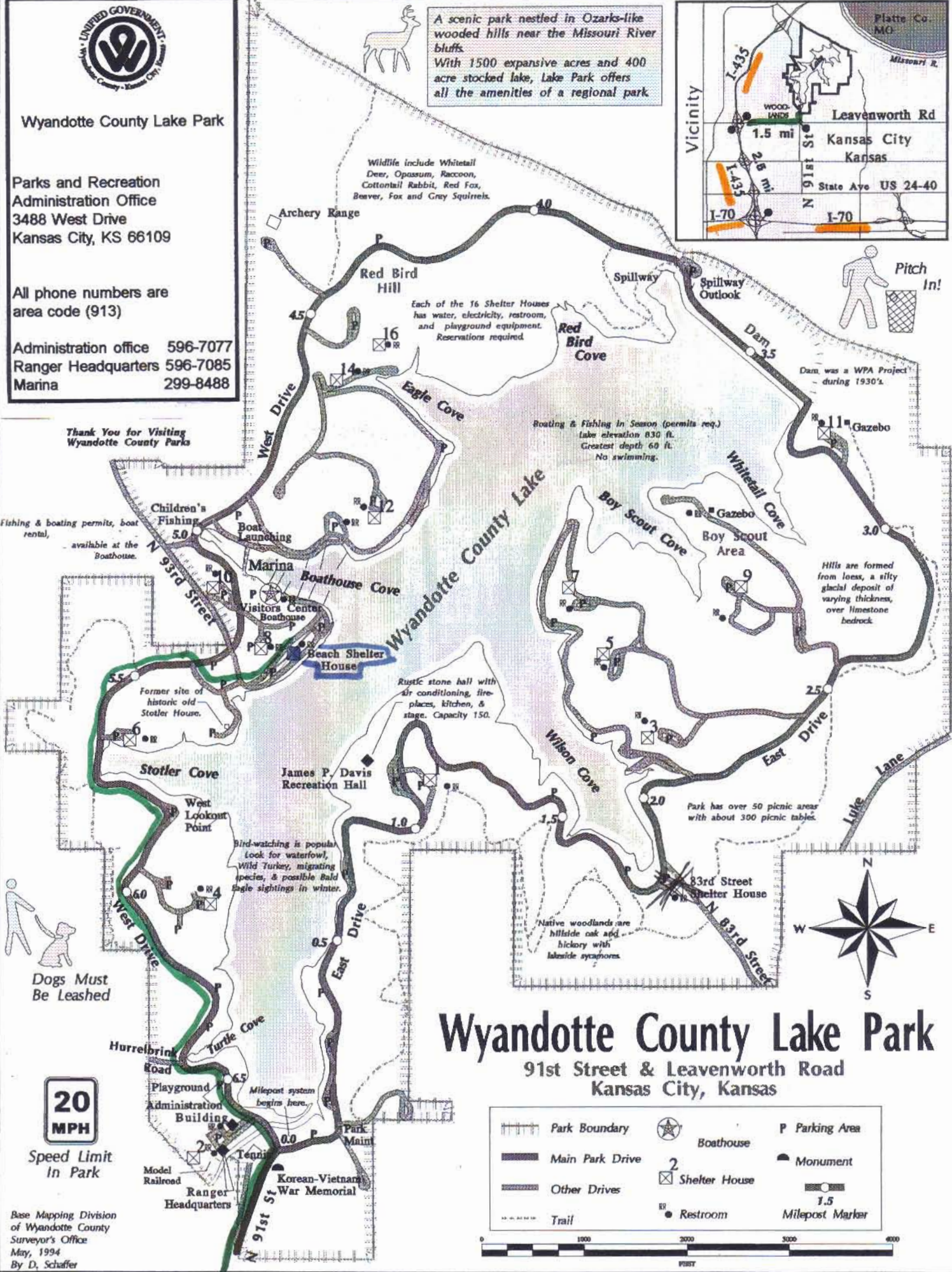
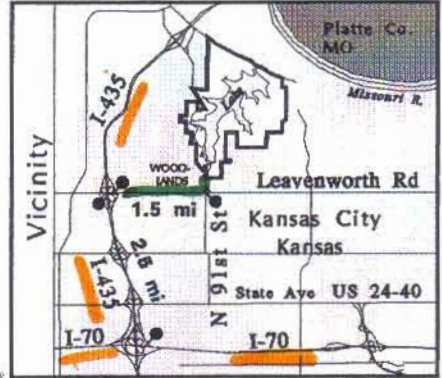
